War Room analysis

Pearman had a few very good games at Virginia, and he's smart and ready to fit in as a decent backup. Some team that knows Al Groh well--such as New England, Cleveland or Miami--may take him late in the draft.

Dan Pompei analysis

Jack-of-all-trades who has been used as a tailback, wide receiver and return man. Runs hard. Is not the biggest or fastest, but has a feel for what it takes. Could be a third-down back who contributes on special teams. **No. 20 on Pompei's RB/FB rankings**

Correspondent Analysis

The Jaguars moved down four spots and picked up an additional sixth-round pick by trading with the New York Jets, then used their fourth-round choice on Pearman, a versatile running back. Pearman doesn't have great speed, and wasn't a regular starter in college, but he showed impressive skills as a receiver and catching passes out of the backfield. Fred Taylor's recent knee surgery prompted the Jaguars to go after a running back in the draft, and they went for Pearman after Florida's Ciatrick Fason was nabbed by Minnesota earlier in the fourth round.
